Students in exam years are, naturally, anxious at this time. Please know that the school will always keep students and parents fully briefed on all information from the DES as soon as we receive the information.






The members of the Art Department continue to support and encourage students during this period of

# Using Xbox or PlayStation to access Office 365

Accessing your school work from home during period of remote teaching and learning can be done through Xbox and PlayStation. This can be useful for any student who does not have access to a laptop/tablet/phone. Follow the steps below -



#### **XBox**

Plug a keyboard into the Xbox USB slot

Go into My Games and Apps

Find Microsoft Edge and select it

Type in: Office 365 / Office.com and log in to your account as you would in school (your hfcs.ie account)

You can access your work through OneDrive and use packages such as:

**Teams** 

Word

Excel

**PowerPoint** 

Outlook/Email

To move from each platform, use the Xbox controller or a mouse



## PlayStation

Identify the PlayStation Internet Browser Icon (it is www with dots around it)

Press the PS4 Logo on the controller

Go to the library and find options for Games and Applications

Go into Applications and you will find the internet browser

Type Office 365 / Office.com into the browser and log in as you would in school (your hfcs.ie account)

You can access your work through OneDrive and use key packages such as:

Excel

**PowerPoint** 

Outlook/email

To move from each platform, use the PS4 controller




## Wellbeing:


