Please read the following information which will inform you of the school's arrangements re Assessment and Reporting on Students' Learning – Junior Cycle 2021:

- All students will receive a State Certificate of Completion of the Junior Cycle from the Department of Education.
- This certificate will state that the student has completed the Junior Cycle programme of study. The certificate will include the list of subjects and short courses studied during their Junior Cycle programme.
- All students will receive a school report reflecting students' learning and achievements at school level.
- After the Easter break, 3rd year students will engage in assessments in each subject.
- Subject teachers will give up to two assessments in each subject.
- Assessments will conclude by 21st May, 2021.
- Students will finish school on the 28th May, 2021.
- Teachers will use these reports and other evidence available to them to award a grade/descriptor to students. Please see the link below for further information.
- School reports will be available via ePortal in June.
