Deputy Principal's Report

- 1. The school would like to commend all students on their excellent adherence to Covid-19 guidelines in school and coming to and from school. Students are happy about the full return to school and we urge all students and parents to work with the school in terms of limiting social contacts so that the school can remain open.
- 2. There has been one positive case of Covid-19 identified. Close contacts have been informed and Public Health will be in touch with families.
- 3. Some teachers who are very high risk are continuing to teach remotely.
- 4. New prefabs will arrive in the coming weeks. It will involve some disruption to parking, although additional car parking spaces have been created at the lower gate. The new prefabs will affect the memorial garden structure. The memorial garden will be moving to an online space.
- 5. The school would like to acknowledge the success of the Easter Raffle which was well supported by parents, students and staff. The results of the raffle were posted on the school website.
- 6. The poly-tunnel will be arriving in about 5 to 6 weeks' time.
- 7. The outdoor benches which were funded by the parents' council will be located in the alcoves to the rear of the school and in the space near the office. The art department will be consulted regarding the design of the benches.
- 8. Last year's graduation was online and it will be the same this year. The school hopes to have some type of in-school event to mark the occasion also, if possible. This is of course dependent on the Covid-19 situation. There is a committee working on this at the moment.
