








• Students who acquire less than 120 credits or who leave the programme early will receive a "Record of Experience".







Do Leaving Certificate Applied students receive a Leaving Certificate?


 Yes. Students who successfully complete the programme receive a Leaving Certificate from the State Examinations Commission.

 permission slip. It is imperative that you read each section of
 the permission slip carefully, so I get the correct information.
 Even if your child cannot attend you must still complete the
 relevant section of the permission slip to indicate they will not
 be attending.
- Due to rapid inflation costs it is imperative that I get EXACT numbers for each trip, so vital funds do not go to waste. Most companies take payment prior to the event, so if you indicate that your child is going on a trip and does not attend their place has more than likely been paid for.
