Fundraiser Initiatives

Lotto Fundraiser Update

An update was provided on the progress of the ongoing school lotto fundraiser:

- Promotion of the school fundraiser has been included in the Rathcoole Newsletter for the month of May.
- There are currently 104 members signed up to participate in the lotto.
- The school's share of funds raised was €1,129.79 in March and €1,336.40 in April. Based on current participation levels, annual income of approximately €12,000 is forecast, provided numbers remain steady or continue to grow.
- The council agreed to continue with the lotto fundraiser and proceed with the permit renewal due in October.
- An extra draw will take place at the end of May, with a prize of two tickets to Taste of Dublin in June.
- It was suggested that additional promotional draws be run during the summer months to maintain momentum. Consideration will also be given to increasing the weekly prize from €20 to €50 at certain times of the year, such as around mid-term breaks, and other key dates to encourage more sign-ups.
- A further call-out was made requesting details of any local businesses that may be interested in supporting or signing up to the fundraiser.
